The candidate should meet the conditions set out in the Act of July 20, 2018: Law on Higher Education and Science (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1668, as amended). Working and remuneration conditions according to the applicable Act.

Requirements:

- PhD in chemistry, physics or related disciplines,
- scientific achievements documented by publications from the JCR list,
- proven knowledge of the English language at a level of at least B2 or equivalent,
- proven experience in the synthesis of coordination compounds or semiconducting materials,
- experience in electrical and spectroscopic measurements, especially in the field of ferroelectrics or memristive elements,
- basic workshop skills in the field of electronics, including the design and construction of simple electrical circuits
- creativity, the ability to work in an international team, communicativeness and diligence.

We offer full-time employment for a specified up to 48 months. A candidate may be a person who meets the following requirements set out in the Act on Higher Education: has the qualifications specified in the Act, has full legal capacity, has not been punished by a final court judgment for an intentional crime, and enjoys full public rights.
